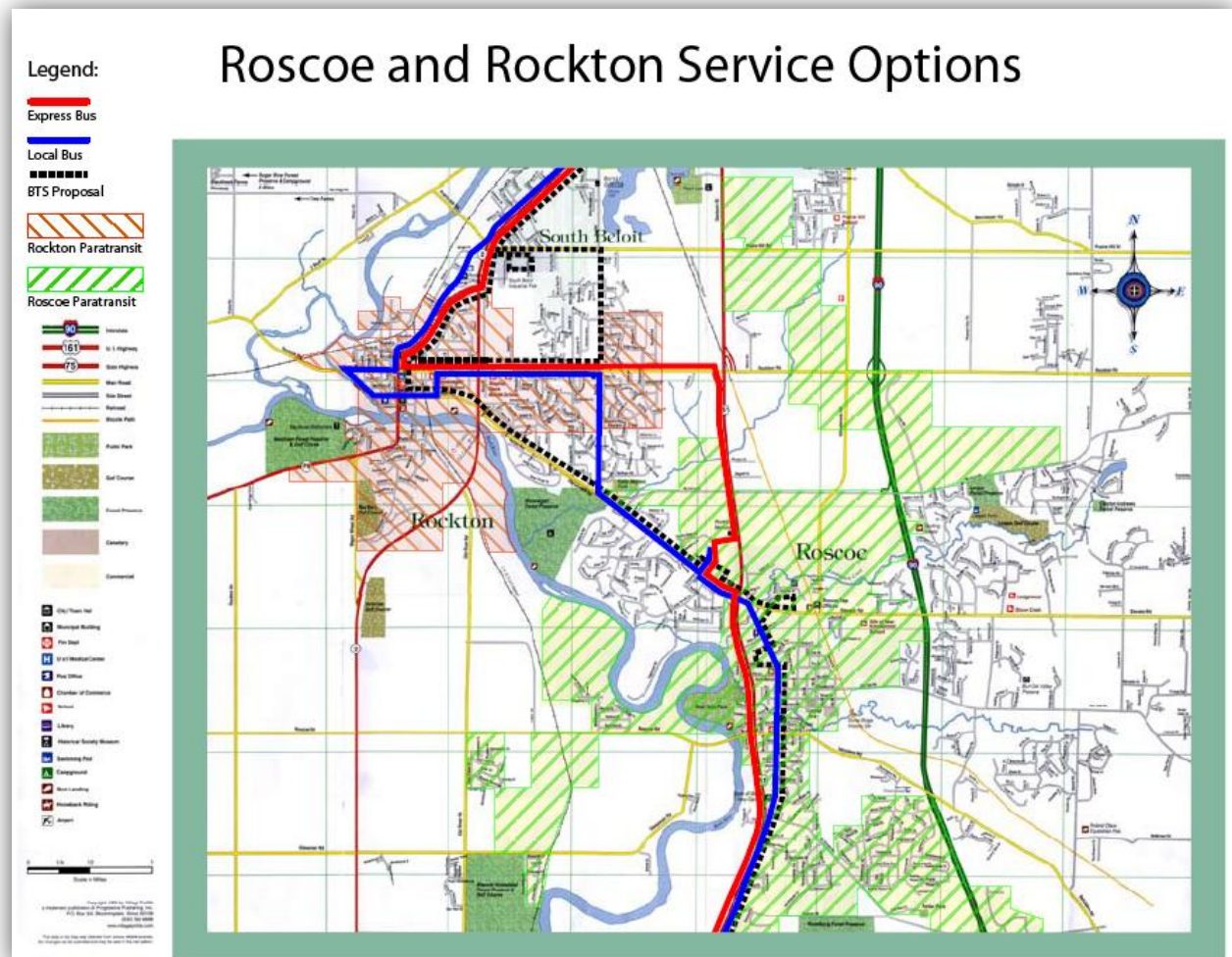


ROSCOE-ROCKTON TRANSIT FEASIBILITY STUDY:

Roscoe and Rockton are neighboring villages located in the corridor between Rockford, Illinois and Beloit, Wisconsin. Though small, the communities are growing rapidly. To avoid the potential congestion that will result from continued growth, and to address the needs of their residents, the communities initiated this feasibility study to enhance their competitiveness and to plan for continued orderly growth.

Vlecides-Schroeder was the contractor on this project, which recommends initiating a demonstration of local on-call service that connects to regional bus service operating in the intercity corridor. Other options to consider include a seasonal water taxi between Rockford and Rockton, operating on the Rock River, and possibly establishing a Mass Transit District with the City of South Beloit, to administer and fund transit operations.
